



## 1. Introduction

The software seeks out files, cookies and registry entries that attempt to feed back information – when connected to the internet - about your computer activity and pc usage.

## 2. The **software included** here:

- a. Spybot Search and Destroy
- b. Ad-Aware SE Personal (superseding version 6)
- c. Spywareblaster
- d. Spywareguard

## 3. Installation

To install the software on a pc navigate to the cd drive

- a. Double-click **aawsepersonal.exe** to install Ad-Aware and automatically replacing version 6 if installed.
  - i. On starting select the option to check for updates.
- b. Double-click **spybotsdxx.exe** to install Spybot.
  - i. **ResetSettings.exe** is a Spybot utility to use if there are any problems running Spybot.
  - ii. After installation of Spybot and starting it up two or three screens should be displayed where you have to click 'Next'. Click any boxes to 'not show this again'.
  - iii. If this does not happen and Spybot starts scanning immediately you will need to run the Reset Settings utility before you try to run Spybot again.
- c. Double-click **spywareblastersetup32.exe** to install **Spywareblaster** and follow the wizard. Once installed continue with the suggested options.
  - i. When you get to the main screen click the Internet Explorer button along the top.
  - ii. Click the two tick boxes to 'Prevent .....' which in turn will select all the items in the list box below.
  - iii. Now click the button below the list box 'Protect Against Checked Items'.
  - iv. Click the Restricted Sites button along the top.
  - v. Click the tick box to 'Prevent .....' which in turn will select all the items in the list box below.
  - vi. Now click the button below the list box 'Protect Against Checked Items'.
  - vii. Do the same for the Mozilla Firefox option, if necessary, but this is normally greyed out.
  - viii. You can now close the window with close **X** top right. This software does not need to be open to work.
- d. Double-click **spywareguardsetup.exe** to install **Spywareguard**. When installed there will be an icon in the system tray (bottom right) and two icons on the desktop.
- e. This software runs in background to monitor activity and blocks most Spyware intrusions.
